

PART 5 BY THE WORD OF THE LORD 1 SAMUEL 3:1-21 THE VISION OF SAMUEL By the Word of the LORD: The Vision of SAMUEL 1 SAMUEL 3:1-21

Though he would grow up to become one of Israel's greatest judges—one used by the LORD to anoint the first kings of Israel including David himself—the prophet **Samuel** came of age in an era when many of God's people were growing dim in their faith. And thus, "In those days the word of the LORD was rare; there were not many visions" (1 Sam 3:1).

By the Word of the LORD: The Vision of SAMUEL 1 SAMUEL 3:1-21

Yet even from his earliest youth, Samuel demonstrated a great responsiveness to the LORD; he learned at a young age to say throughout his life: "Speak LORD, for Your servant is listening" (1 Sam 3:9). We can also follow Samuel's example today so that we, too, would see the revelation available as we live By the Word of the LORD.

By the Word of the LORD: The Vision of SAMUEL 1 SAMUEL 3:1-21

1. Dark Days: When No Vision Spread (vv.1-7)

2. Open Ears: When God Calls (vv.8-15)

3. Strong Words: When God Reveals (vv.16-21)

1 SAMUEL 3:1-7

¹ The boy Samuel ministered before the LORD under Eli [the priest]. In those days the word of the LORD was rare; there were not many visions [LIT: no vision spread abroad]. 2 One night Eli, whose eyes were becoming so weak that he could barely see, was lying down in his usual place. ³ The lamp of God had not yet gone out, & Samuel was lying down in the house of the LORD, where the Ark of God was. ⁴ Then the LORD called Samuel. Samuel answered, "Here I am." ⁵ And he ran to Eli & said, "Here I am; you called me." But Eli said, "I did not call; go back & lie down." So he went & lay down. 6 Again the LORD called, "Samuel!" And Samuel got up & went to Eli & said, "Here I am; you called me." "My son," Eli said, "I did not call; go back & lie down." ⁷ Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD: The word of the LORD had not yet been revealed to him.

"The 'word of the LORD' is often a technical term referring to oracular message [the discerning of which was] a priestly function, & so there is an intimation here of some sort of breakdown in the professional performance of the house of Eli. But the same phrase also is used to announce prophecy, & 'vision' is a prophetic term: the whole episode concerns the transition from priestly to prophetic authority."

1 SAMUEL 3:1-7

ELI (v.2)

- Nighttime (DARKNESS)
- Eyes so weak he can barely see (BLINDNESS)
- Laying down to sleep "in his usual place" (LETHARGY / COMPLACENCY)

GOD (v.3)

- Lamp still lit (LIGHT / SIGHT)
- House still standing (STRENGTH)
- Ark of the Covenant in place (LEGACY / PURPOSE / POWER)

SAMUEL (VV.3-7)

- Listening, attentive (SOUND & SIGHT)
- Laying down in the sanctuary (PREPARED / WORSHIPFUL)
- Called in a pattern of threes; uninitiated (POTENTIAL / PURPOSE / PURITY)

1 SAMUEL 3:1-7

ELI (v.2)

 "Where there is no vision, the people perish, but the one who keeps to God's word is bound to be blessed." (PROV 29:18)

GOD (v.3)

- "In the beginning....God said, 'Let there be light,' & there was light. God saw that [it] was good, &...separated [it] from the darkness." (GEN 1:1-4)
- "In the beginning was the Word [&] the Word was God....In Him was life, & that life was the light of all humanity. The light shines in the darkness, & the darkness has not overcome it." (JN 1:1-5)

SAMUEL (VV.3-7)

"Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a
voice behind you, saying, 'This is the way; walk in it."" (ISA 30:21)

2. Open Ears: When God Calls

1 SAMUEL 3:8-15

8 A third time the LORD called, "Samuel!" And Samuel got up & went to Eli-& said, "Here I am; you called me." Then Eli realized that the LORD was calling the boy. 9 So Eli told Samuel, "Go & lie down, & if He calls you, say, 'Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening.'" So Samuel went & lay down in his place. 10 The LORD came & stood there, calling as at the other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" Then Samuel said, "Speak, for your servant is listening." 11 And the LORD said to Samuel: "See, I am about to do something in Israel that will make the ears of everyone who hears about it tingle. 12 At that time I will carry out against Eli everything I spoke against his family—from beginning to end. 13 For I told him that I would judge his family forever because of the sin he knew about; his sons blasphemed God, & he failed to restrain them. 14 Therefore I swore to the house of Eli, 'The guilt of Eli's house will never be atoned for by sacrifice or offering." 15 Samuel lay down until morning & then opened the doors of the house of the LORD. He was afraid to tell Eli the vision...

1 SAMUEL 3:1-7

16 ...but Eli called...& said, "Samuel, my son." Samuel answered, "Here I am." 17 "What was it He said to you?" Eli asked. "Do not hide it from me. May God deal with you, be it ever so severely, if you hide from me anything He told you." 18 So Samuel told him everything, hiding nothing from him. Then Eli said, "He is the LORD; let Him do what is good in His eyes." 19 The LORD was with Samuel as he grew up, & He let none of Samuel's words fall to the ground. 20 And all Israel from Dan to Beersheba recognized that Samuel was attested as a prophet of the LORD. 21 And the LORD appeared again at Shiloh, because the LORD revealed Himself to Samuel at Shiloh by the word of the LORD.
